BWA Women's Leadership Conference Information

July 24-27, 2010

Sheraton Waikiki Hotel

Waikiki, Hawaii



Held immediately prior to the Baptist World Alliance Congress, this conference seeks to: 1) Gather Baptist women from around the world; 2) Discover how God is impacting the world through women; 3) Raise awareness of the issues that affect women's lives; and 4) Equip women to become more effective in Christian response.

Schedule:

- **Saturday**, July 24—Morning and afternoon registration; opening session Aloha dinner.
- **Sunday and Monday**, July 25 and 26—Each day will begin with praise and worship. The two issues to be presented during the morning sessions are poverty and abuse as they relate to women and children. These two issues will be explored through Bible study, papers presenting the state of women today, responses of actual activities being done to make a difference, and a time of personal commitment. The afternoon sessions will be filled with exciting activities that will help to change poverty and abuse towards women and children. The evening sessions will include praise and worship, testimonies and cultural expressions from all seven continental unions.
- **Tuesday**, July 27—After hearing responses to the issues the conference will close with the installation of new BWA Women's Department officers and a morning tea reception for the new officers.

Conference Location

The Sheraton Waikiki hotel is located on Waikiki beach where all of the sessions of the women's Leadership Conference will be held. The BWA Congress will be held at the Hawaii Convention Center which is only one mile from the Sheraton Waikiki.

Registration

Conference Registration Fee:

- \$175 (USD) before March 31, 2010
- \$200 (USD) after March 31, 2010
- Visitors: one day only fee: \$60 (USD)

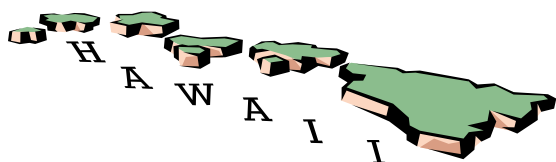

Meals

Breakfast is not included in the hotel price. Each person will be responsible for 3 breakfasts and 2 evening meals. There is a very good food court and several reasonably priced restaurants close to the conference venue.

Travel and Health Insurance

It is essential that you take out travel and health insurance. Medical fees are very expensive. You are responsible for any expenses related to your personal travel and medical care.



Cancellation Policy

Cancellations must be made in writing by May 1, 2010. An administration fee of \$25 (USD) per person will apply to all cancellations made by this date. There will be no refunds after the cancellation deadline.

Scholarship Fund

One of the purposes of this meeting is "to gather Baptist women from around the world". Many women will not be able to attend without assistance. The average cost to bring one Baptist woman to this conference is about \$2,500 (USD). An opportunity is provided, on the back of the registration form, for you to contribute to the Scholarship Fund. Your donation will make a world of difference.
